GLOBAL SUPPORT TO INDUSTRIALS:

SUEZ WINS TWO NEW CONTRACTS TO SUPPLY CUTTING EDGE WATER TREATMENT TECHNOLOGIES

The Group announces two new international contracts in Brazil and in Russia. Under these new contracts, SUEZ brings its expertise in water related technologies and solutions to industrial clients on key industrial markets, including Energy. The leading-edge technologies provided by SUEZ enable industrials to ensure operational excellence, improve their environmental performance and comply with the most stringent regulations.

In Brazil, MODEC Offshore Production Systems has awarded a multi-million euro contract to SUEZ for the supply of seawater sulphate removal technology. This comes as part of MODEC's construction of a new floating production, storage, and offloading (FPSO) vessel on behalf of Equinor Norway¹. MODEC will use SUEZ's ultrafiltration and nanofiltration membranes to reduce seawater sulphate levels to required levels. The contract includes equipment supply, engineering, project management, procurement and construction supervision. This latest win marks the second contract with MODEC in a span of 6 months.

In Russia, SUEZ has signed a contract to supply technology for a large wastewater treatment project and to establish an associated 10-year service agreement with Irkutsk Polymer Plant of Irkutsk Oil Company, one of the largest independent oil and gas producer building a new polymer plant in the Eastern Siberia region of the country. SUEZ will treat all wastewater from the new plant using 3 main technologies: membrane bioreactor (MBR), electro dialysis reversal (EDR) and thermal vapor recompression (TVR). The combination of technologies will enable the plant to reach near-zero liquid discharge (ZLD) and implement water reuse, thereby limiting the plant's impact on the environment. The treatment process will also allow the Irkutsk Polymer Plant to meet strict government regulations for discharge. Once commissioned in 2024, the wastewater treatment plant will treat a total maximum design flow of 9 600 m³ each day.

"These contracts confirm the Group's strategy to lead its industrial clients towards more sustainable growth. Through the implementation of responsible models and new technologies, the Group commits to providing excellent services while preserving the environment, all over the world. In line with the SUEZ 2030 strategic plan, these contracts demonstrate the Group's ability to pursue its international expansion and accelerate its development in key industrial markets." commented **Christophe Cros, Senior Executive Vice President of SUEZ, in charge of the North America Region and President of Water Technologies & Solutions.**
