We are proud to announce this acquisition, which represents a new phase of SUEZ's development in Europe. It shows our ambition to develop a range of waste processing solutions that have recycling and energy recovery at their core, in order to offer our Italian clients increasingly circular solutions in support of their ecological transition."

Salvatore Mazzotta, CEO of Ecosistem declared: "In a span of nearly 40 years, Ecosistem has grown from a used oil and batteries collection company into a leader in environmental solutions with more than 400 employees. Joining forces with SUEZ, we look forward to expanding our offering with innovative solutions in recycling and resource recovery."

All the market segments in which Gruppo Ecosistem operates represent major growth opportunities, relating to the treatment of industrial effluents, energy recovery from waste and the remediation of polluted sites.

Gruppo Ecosistem's founders will retain an equity stake in the business and will continue to support its development.
